

COMPULSORY ATTENDANCE AGES

The district acknowledges that All children normally are required by New York State law to attend school full time, in a public, private or parochial school, unless exempt from attendance in conjunction with current law or regulation, from the first day of session in September of the school year in which the minor becomes six years of age through the last day of the school year in which such minor becomes sixteen years of age on or before December 1, unless he/she has completed a four-year high school course of study. A minor who has completed a four-year high school course of study is not required to attend.

The Board of Education, through the Superintendent as chief administrative officer, is responsible for enforcement of the Compulsory Education Law.
