

ADMISSION OF NON-RESIDENT STUDENTS

The district will not accept students who are not bonafide residents* of the Horseheads Central School District except children of district employees. Children of district employees may be admitted tuition-free into grades K-12 during the period the parent is an employee of the district. Students must comply with the district's Code of Conduct. If the parent's district employment terminates during the school year, the student shall be allowed to complete that school year. It shall be the district employee's responsibility to provide transportation for their non-resident child(ren) to and from school on the days that school is in session.

The district recognizes the value of cultural diversity brought about by exchange students. The Superintendent of Schools is authorized to accept exchange students as bonafide residents in accordance with the rulings of the Commissioner of Education, provided that the exchange student complies with the federal immigration law and does not constitute an undue burden on the school district.

Where required by law to accept students placed in the district by a Social Service Agency or otherwise, the tuition shall be the maximum amount permissible and calculated to be due pursuant to Part 174 of the Regulations of the Commissioner of Education as now in effect or hereafter amended. Such tuition shall be billed and payable in advance in non-refundable, semi-annual installments, one-half on or before September 10 and one-half on or before January 10.
