REGULAR MEETINGS

The Board of Education shall attempt to hold regular meetings on the first and third Thursday of each month unless it is a legal holiday, in which case it may be held the following day, following week, or canceled. Meetings may be held in any location within the district. Meetings may also be rotated among the schools in the district. The Board shall establish actual dates and places for such meetings by resolution at a Board meeting prior to July 1. Meeting dates and places may be changed, if necessary, by the President of the Board and the Superintendent of Schools with advanced notice being given.

If there is a need to cancel a Board meeting during any emergency school closing, the decision will be made as early in the day as possible by the Superintendent and the Board President. Board members and media will be notified of such determination. Any meeting so canceled may be held the first day that school is reopened following such closing or the meeting may be rescheduled or canceled.

All regular monthly meetings of the Board shall start at 7 p.m. unless otherwise specified.

REGULAR MEETINGS

In order to perform its duties in an open and public manner, and in accordance with state law, the Board of Education shall hold regular business meetings not less than once a month. Meetings may be held in any location within the district, including a rotation among the schools in the district. The Board shall establish actual dates and places for such meetings by resolution at a Board meeting in June. Meeting dates and places may be changed, if necessary, by the President of the Board and the Superintendent of Schools with advanced notice being given.

If there is a need to cancel a Board meeting during any emergency school closing, the decision will be made as early in the day as possible by the Superintendent of Schools and the Board President. Board members and media will be notified of such determination. Any meeting so cancelled will be rescheduled as soon as possible following such closing or the meeting may be cancelled.

All regular monthly meetings of the Board shall start at 7 p.m.*

*** For the 2010-2011 school year, the Board of Education meetings will be start at 6 p.m.**
