Leave is requested for the following purpose or purposes: <u>I am planning to travel to Greece</u>, where I will be 1) creating a unit on classical literature for my seventh graders; 2) visiting a US Military middle school classroom, to learn what their standards and practices are, and; 3) to establish a relationship with the students in that classroom to create a working relationship with my own class. This will enable the kids in Greece to have a connection with their home (they are all American children of Military parents), and will help to teach both groups how to work with others via technologies such as webconferencing, collaborating via wikis and blogs, as well as traditional methods such as letter writing (part of the 7th Grade curriculum). The students will gain an appreciation of another culture from their peers – this is an invaluable opportunity for them.

As the paradigms for collaboration in the workplace and in education change due to emerging technologies, this will give my students an opportunity to begin developing 21st century skills that will aid them throughout their adult lives.

I plan on keeping a web diary in the form of a video/written blog, and plan on using webconferencing to continue to collaborate with my class, and have real-time conversations with my students. This will not only illustrate for them the capabilities of the technology, but also enable me to share my learning experience with them.

Monetary compensation will be received as follows: <u>Leave with pay for nine (9) days; all other</u> expenses (excluding substitute pay) to be paid by me.

Special comments: ______ This is an incredible opportunity for both myself and my students – it is a way to actually put into practice things that I can new only discuss with my class theoretically.
