SMOKING ON SCHOOL PREMISES BY STAFF

The Board of Education, recognizing health hazards associated with smoking and in accordance with federal and state law, prohibits smoking or **the use of tobacco-related products, at all times**, in all school buildings, on school property, at school-sponsored **activities**, or in any vehicle used to transport children or personnel.

Staff violating this policy will be subject to appropriate disciplinary measures.

The Superintendent of Schools or his/her designee will have copies of this policy prominently posted in the workplace. In addition, the Superintendent will designate an agent to be responsible for informing individuals smoking in a non-smoking area that they are in violation of Article 13 of the Public Health Law and/or the federal Pro-Children Act of 1994.
