# Varsity Winter Cheerleaders Battle on the Boardwalk Nationals 2011 Itinerary Explanations

## **Friday, February 4, 2011**

Students and parents will depart from Horseheads High School at 4:00pm. The approximate drive will take 5 hours and 11 minutes. Students and parents will pack a bag-dinner to eat en route to Atlantic City.

Upon arrival to Atlantic City, cheerleaders will check-in to the hotel and settle into their rooms. The rooming list is attached. Veteran cheerleaders will room with younger cheerleaders to encourage team bonding. Cheerleaders will report to Coach Shane's room for a team bonding activity that will take about an hour. Cheerleaders will then return to their rooms to go to bed. Coach Shane tape the girls doors at 11:00pm and will check the doors periodically during the night.

## **Saturday, February 5, 2011**

Cheerleaders will have an 8:00a.m. wake-up call to prepare for the competition. Cheerleaders will meet in the lobby of the hotel for a continental breakfast at 9:00a.m. Cheerleaders will have two hours to get ready to depart the hotel for the competition. Cheerleaders will meet in Coach Shane's room at 11a.m. to leave. The hotel is attached to the competition site. Competition time will be announced on Friday, February 4 at the coach's meeting. Once competition time is announced a more solid schedule for Saturday, February 5 will be ready. Cheerleaders will eat lunch in the convention center after warming up and competing.

Following competition, cheerleaders will remain seated in the team section together until awards. Following awards, cheerleaders will return to the hotel and have about an hour of time to change their clothes and relax before heading out to dinner at Tun Tavern with all families and friends in attendance. Tun Tavern is connected to the competition site as well.

After dinner, cheerleaders will return to the hotel and lights out will be at 12a.m.

## **Sunday, February 6, 2011**

Cheerleaders will meet in the lobby of the hotel for a continental breakfast at 9:00a.m. Cheerleaders will check out of the hotel at 11a.m. and return to Horseheads.

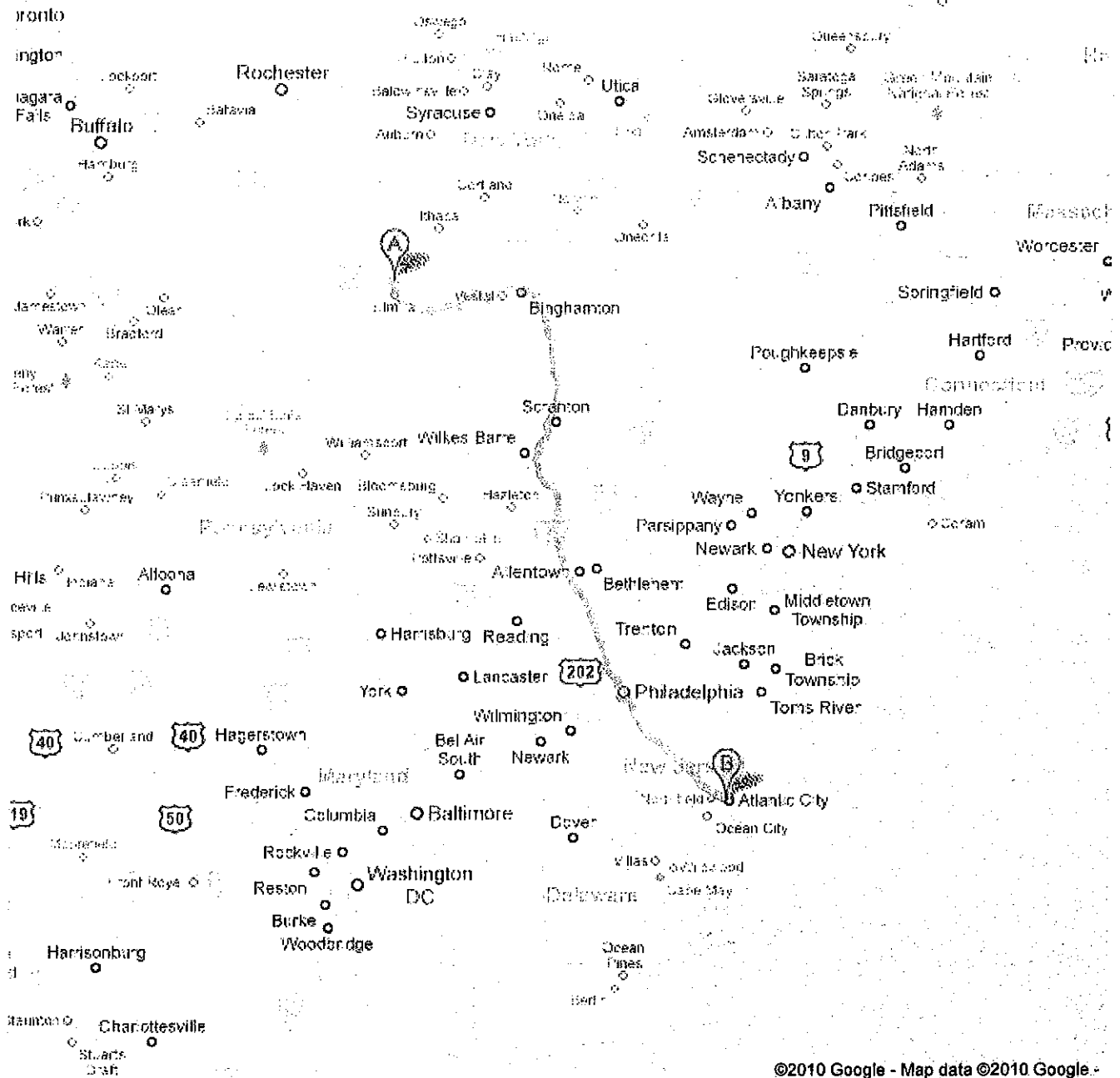
