Request to apply pesticide

On August 13, 2011 the Football field treated with a pesticide to mitigate Bluegrass Billbugs. The infestation kills the grass which creates an uneven and unsafe footing on the field. The original application only treated one part of the Billbug lifecycle. Since then, adult billbugs have been identified in high enough numbers to warrant follow up applications to completely get rid of them. The request is to apply Sevan between the second and third week of April with a final application 14 days after. The field will be off limits during the time it is being treated. These applications will ensure the complete eradication of the pest.
