ADULT EDUCATION PROGRAMS

The Board of Education shall maintain a comprehensive program of adult education to serve the needs and desires of the community.

The adult education program will be administered by the Superintendent or his/her designee and shall be self-supporting through the collection of appropriate fees as well as through state and federal aid. School facilities and equipment shall be available for adult education instruction when such use will not interfere with regular school activities.

Adult Occupational Education

The Board shall support adult occupational education and other adult educational activities through school district participation in the Schuyler-Chemung-Tioga Area (change this to GST) BOCES adult education programs.

School district support of the BOCES adult education program shall continue as long as such programs are self-supported by a combination of fees, state and federal aid and other local aid that is not derived from taxes.
