## ASSIGNMENT OF STUDENTS TO SCHOOLS AND CLASSES

Students enrolled in regular courses of instruction shall be assigned to the school serving such student's geographical area for the grade level involved. The attendance boundaries for district elementary ~~and middle~~ schools may be adjusted from year to year in accordance with Board of Education ~~policy~~. (Add: resolution)

The Superintendent of Schools shall have the authority to honor individual requests for specific school and class assignments when he/she determines that such requests are in the best interest of the student and are compatible with the goals and policies of the district. The Superintendent may require that certain terms and conditions be adhered to in order to grant any special requests.

The Principal of each school will be responsible for assigning students to classes within his or her school.
