4. Forfeiture Clause: If this contract is broken by participating team, said party shall forfeit the sum of Entry Fee.
5. Special Stipulations Weather permitting, each team will play at least 4 games and no more than 5 games. The first 3 games are pool play followed by a four team single elimination bracket.
